

Summer Art Camps

Art camp is a unique and fun way to spend your summer! Our camps offer specialized instruction in a variety of projects.

"Mommy and Me" Art Camp (ages 2 to 4). This special parent/child class is often the first educational program for our toddlers. Children learn about color, about texture and more while experimenting with new and innovative materials. Parents/Caregivers learn what they can do to nurture creativity.

Each Art Camp session has 6 classes, meeting on Monday, Wednesday and Friday for two weeks, July 9 - 20. Register for either the morning Art Camp from 10:00 to 11:30 or the afternoon Art Camp from 2:00 to 3:30. The cost is \$120 which includes supplies.

Children's Art Camp (ages 5 to 9). In this excellent hands-on class your child will actively create their own masterpieces. This will be an ARTrageous place to explore various mediums. Students learn the mechanics of drawing and will be introduced to artistic styles, drawing tools, and special techniques as they develop their unique creations.

Each Art Camp session has 6 classes, meeting on Monday, Wednesday and Friday for two weeks, July 23 - August 3. Register for either the morning Art Camp from 10:00 to 11:30 or the afternoon Art Camp from 2:00 to 3:30. The cost is \$120 which includes supplies.

Class Size: Due to careful project preparation, payment is due at time of registration. Due to limited class size, space is available on a first come, first served basis.

Cancellation Policy: If cancellation is received 10 days prior to the start date of the class, the tuition will be refund less a \$50 cancellation fee.
